

Local Rules

Out of Bounds is defined by: Perimeter walls and Fences, course-side edge of paved public road (Winter Street). The course-side edge of the white traffic line is the boundary. White Stakes; fences where tied into with white stakes and/or white paint lines.

Penalty Areas are defined by red stakes and lines.

Ground Under Repair: French drains, outcrops of bare rock, areas enclosed by white lines or otherwise marked.

Local Rules:

- All stone walls are integral parts of the course.
- Worn or damaged areas contiguous with the artificially surfaced cart paths and roads are deemed to be part of these paths and roads.

Inclement Weather: A long horn blast will alert players to dangerous weather conditions. Players are to immediately discontinue play and seek shelter. Safe shelter is provided at the 10th tee shack, cart storage and clubhouse areas. Under no circumstance is anyone permitted back on the course until the system rings an all clear.

Immovable Obstructions Close To Putting Greens: For a ball in the *general area*, relief is allowed only when both the ball and the *immovable obstruction* lie in an area cut to fairway height or less. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b if an *immovable obstruction* is: Ball in General Area. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b if an *immovable obstruction* is:

- On the *line of play*, and is:
- Within two *club-lengths* of the *putting green*, and
- Within two *club-lengths* of the ball.

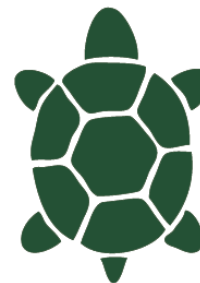
